ORDINANCE, 1973: PROMULGATION OF

ORDONNANSIE, 1973: UITVAARDIGING VAN

The Administrator has been pleased to assent, in terms of section 27 of the South West Africa Constitution Act, 1968 (Act 39 of 1968) to the following Ordinance which is hereby published for general information in terms of section 29 of the said Act.

MUNICIPAL DOG TAX AMENDMENT ORDINANCE, 1973.

(Assented to 27 June 1973.)

(Afrikaans text signed by the Administrator.)

(Date of commencement 3 July 1973.)

ORDINANCE

To amend the Municipal Dog Tax Ordinance, 1967, so as to substitute the expression "Executive Committee" for the word "Administrator"; to define the expression Executive Committee; to provide that the provisions of the said Ordinance may be applied to peri-urban areas; and to provide for incidental matters.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Legislative Assembly for the Territory of South West Africa as follows:—

Amendment of Ordinance 13 of 1967 to substitute the expression "Executive Committee" for the word "Administrator".

1. The Municipal Dog Tax Ordinance, 1967 (Ordinance 13 of 1967) — hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance — is hereby amended by the substitution for the word "Administrator" wherever it appears of the expression "Executive Committee".

Amendment of section 1 of Ordinance 13 of 1967, as amended by section 1 of Ordinance 41 of 1967.

2. Section 1 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion after the definition of "dog" of the following definition:

" "Executive Committee" means the Administrator-in-Executive Committee as referred to in section 6 of the South West Africa Constitution Act, 1968 (Act 39 of 1968);".

Substitution of section 16 of Ordinance 13 of 1967.

3. The following section is hereby substituted for section 16 of the principal Ordinance:

"Application of Ordinance to Village Management Board areas and peri-urban areas.

16. The Executive Committee may by proclamation in the *Official Gazette* apply the provisions of sections 1 to 15, inclusive, to any Village Management Board area referred to in section 3 of the Village Management Boards Ordinance, 1963 (Ordinance 14 of 1963) and any area declared by the Executive Committee to be a peri-urban area within the scope of the Peri-Urban Development Board Ordinance, 1970 (Ordinance

19 of 1970) as from a date to be specified in such proclamation in which event those provisions shall *mutatis mutandis* apply to such Village Management Board area and the Village Management Board constituted for such Village Management Board area in terms of the said section 3 as well as for such peri-urban area and in respect of such peri-urban area the Peri-Urban Development Board established under section 2 of the Peri-Urban Development Board Ordinance, 1970 (Ordinance 19 of 1970).".

AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS FOR THE CONTROL OF DOGS IN MUNICIPAL AREAS.

The Executive Committee has under and by virtue of the provisions of section 15 of the Municipal Dog Tax Ordinance, 1967 (Ordinance 13 of 1967) amended the regulations promulgated under Government Notice 131 of 1968 by the substitution of the following regulation for regulation 1:

"1. For the purpose of these regulations unless the context indicates otherwise, words and expressions shall have the meanings assigned to them in Ordinance 13 of 1967 and on application thereof to —

- (a) any village management board area the words "council" and "municipality" shall mean "board and board area";
- (b) any peri-urban area the words "council" and "municipality" shall mean "Peri-Urban Development Board" and "peri-urban area".
