CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT, 1998: AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE NO. 1

- Under section 54 of the Customs and Excise Act, 1998, (Act No. 20 of 1998), Schedule No. 1 to the Act is amended by the substitution of the Additional Notes to Chapter 22 of the following:

“ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- 1.(a) For the purposes of this Chapter, ‘traditional African beer’ means beer made by the fermentation of malt or unmalted grain or meal or sorghum, maize, finger millet or pearl millet of which the fermentation has not been arrested: Provided that -
 - the alcohol content does not exceed 3.5 per cent by volume;
 - no ethyl alcohol has been added;

- (iii) it does not contain and has not been flavoured with hops or products derived from hops; and
 - (iv) any sugar which may have been added does not exceed 5 per cent mass by mass of such malt or unmalted grain or meal of sorghum, maize, finger millet or pearl millet.
- (b) The expressions ‘unfortified wine’ and ‘unfortified fermented apple, pear and orange beverages’ mean wine and fermented apple, pear and orange beverages with an alcoholic strength not exceeding 16 per cent of alcohol by volume and the expressions ‘fortified wine’ and ‘fortified fermented apple, pear and orange beverages’ mean wine and fermented apple, pear and orange beverages with an alcoholic strength exceeding 16 per cent of alcohol by volume.”.

2. This amendment is deemed to have come into operation on 18 February 2004.
