AMENDMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH COVID-19 GENERAL REGULATIONS:
PUBLIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH ACT, 2015

SCHEDULE

Definitions

No. 246

1. In these regulations "the Regulations" means the Public Health Covid-19 General Regulations published under Government Notice No. 91 of 30 April 2021 as amended by Government Notices No. 108 of 31 May 2021, No. 128 of 16 June 2021, No. 138 of 30 June 2021, No. 144 of 9 July 2021, No.151 of 15 July 2021, No. 160 of 31 July 2021, No. 175 of 14 August 2021, No. 189 of 6 September 2021, No. 205 of 15 September 2021 and No. 232 of 15 October 2021.

Amendment of regulation 7 of Regulations

- **2.** Regulation 7 of the Regulations is amended by the substitution for subregulation (3) of the following subregulation:
 - "(3) Despite any contrary condition applicable to any type of liquor licence issued under the Liquor Act, the sale of liquor in terms of a liquor licence and the purchase of liquor may -
 - (a) where the seller is the holder of an off-sales licence, only take place -
 - (i) starting from 09:00 until 18:00 on Mondays to Fridays; and
 - (ii) starting from 09:00 until 13:00 on Saturdays,

but the sale and purchase of liquor may not take place on Sundays or public holidays;

- (b) where the seller is the holder of an on-consumption licence, only take place -
 - (i) starting from 09:00 until 24:00 on Mondays to Saturdays; and
 - (ii) starting from 14:00 until 22:00 on Sundays, if the applicable liquor licence permits the sale of liquor on Sundays,

but the sale and purchase of liquor may not take place on public holidays;

- (c) where the seller is the holder of an on-consumption licence which permits the sale of liquor after 24:00, only take place -
 - (i) starting from 09:00 until 02:00 on Mondays to Saturdays; and
 - (ii) starting from 14:00 until 22:00 on Sundays, if the applicable liquor licence permits the sale of liquor on Sundays,

but the sale and purchase of liquor may not take place on public holidays;

- (d) where -
 - (i) the seller is the holder of an on-consumption licence;
 - (ii) the liquor is sold at an accommodation establishment, restaurant or similar establishment; and
 - (iii) the applicable liquor licence permits the sale of liquor on Sundays and public holidays,

only take place starting from 09:00 until 24:00 on each day of the week.".
