PROMULGATION OF ACT OF PARLIAMENT

The following Act which has been passed by the Parliament and signed by the President in terms of the Namibian Constitution is hereby published in terms of Article 56 of that Constitution.

No. 16 of 1997: Additional Appropriation Act, 1997.

ACT

To appropriate amounts of money to meet the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 1998.

(Signed by the President on 19 December 1997)

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of Namibia, as follows:-

Appropriation of amounts of money for financial requirements of the State

1. Subject to the provisions of the State Finance Act, 1991 (Act No. 31 of 1991), there are hereby appropriated for the financial requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 1998, as a charge to the State Revenue Fund, the additional amounts of money shown in the Schedule.

Short title

2. This Act shall be called the Additional Appropriation Act, 1997.
