# PROCEDURE FOR ADVERTISING IN THE GOVERNMENT GAZETTE OF THE REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA

- 3. Advertisements are published in this *Government Gazette* for the benefit of the public and must be furnished in English by the advertiser or his agent.
- 4. Only legal advertisements shall be accepted for publication in the *Government Gazette* (Estates) and are subject to the approval of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Justice, who may refuse the acceptance of further publication of any advertisement.
- 5. The Ministry of Justice reserves the right to edit and revise copy and to delete there from any superfluous detail.

# ORDER OF COURT

# IN THE HIGH COURT OF NAMIBIA

Applicant

Having read the documents filed and having heard Mr David Smuts for the Applicant and having considered the matter.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- a meeting ("the scheme meeting") in terms of section 311(1) of the Companies Act, 61 of 1973, as amended ("the Companies Act") of the members of the Applicant (other than NedNamibia Holdings Limited ("NedNamibia")) recorded in the register as such at the close of business on Friday, 21 January 2005 ("the scheme members") be convened by the Chairman referred to in paragraph 2 of this Order of Court ("this Order") to be held at Nampower Convention Centre, c/o Goethe & Uhland Streets, Windhoek, Namibia on Friday, 28 January 2005 at 10h00, for the purpose of considering and, if deemed fit, agreeing, with or without modification, to the scheme of arrangement ("the scheme") proposed by NedNamibia Holdings Limited between the Applicant and the scheme members, substantially in the form contained in the papers before this Honourable Court;
- advocate Raymond Heathcote (or failing him an independent person approved by this Court) be and is hereby appointed as Chairman of the scheme meeting ("the Chairman");
- 3. the Chairman of the scheme meeting is authorised to:
  - 3.1 convene the scheme meeting and preside over the scheme meeting;
  - 3.2 appoint scrutineers for the purpose of the scheme meeting including any adjournment thereof;
  - 3.3 determine the validity and acceptability of any form of proxy submitted for use at the scheme meeting and/or any adjournment thereof;
  - 3.4 adjourn the scheme meeting from time to time if the Chairman considers it necessary to do so; and

  - that a copy of this Order, the scheme and the explanatory statement in terms of section 312(1) of the Companies Act may be obtained free of charge on request during normal business hours by any scheme member at the place mentioned in paragraph 5.4 of this Order;

- 6. notice of the scheme meeting be given by the Applicant to the scheme members by the Applicant posting copies of the following documents by pre-paid post at least 21 (twenty one) calendar days before the date of the scheme meeting to each of the scheme members at their addresses as reflected in the Applicant's register of members at the close of business on a date not more than 5 (five) business days before the date of such posting:
  - 6.1 the scheme and the explanatory statement in terms of section 312(1) of the Companies Act substantially in the form of the scheme and explanatory statement attached to the papers before this Honourable Court;
  - 6.2 the notice convening the scheme meeting substantially in the form of the notice attached to the papers before this Honourable Court showing the time, date and place of the scheme meeting;
  - 6.3 the form of proxy to be used at the scheme meeting substantially in the form of the form of proxy attached to the papers before this Honourable Court; and
  - 6.4 this Order of Court;

## 7. copies of:

- 7.1 the scheme and the explanatory statement in terms of section 312(1) of the Companies Act substantially in the form of the scheme and the explanatory statement attached to the papers before this Honourable Court;
- 7.2 the notice convening the scheme meeting substantially in the form of the notice attached to the papers before this Court;
- 7.3 a form of proxy substantially in the form of the form of proxy attached to the papers before this Court: and
- 7.4 this Order of Court,

shall lie for inspection at, and copies of these documents may be obtained free of charge from, the registered office of the Applicant at 12 - 20 Dr Frans Indongo Street, Windhoek during normal business hours at least 21 (twenty one) calendar days prior to the date of the scheme meeting;

- 8. the date of posting of the documents referred to in paragraph 6 shall be evidenced by an affidavit deposed by a representative of the Applicant;
- 9. the Chairman shall report by way of affidavit the results of the scheme meeting to this Honourable Court by no later than Monday the 7th of February 2005 at 10h00 or so soon thereafter as Counsel may be heard;
- 10. the report required by this Honourable Court from the Chairman shall give details of:
  - 10.1 the number of scheme members present in person at the scheme meeting or any adjournment thereof (including those represented) and the number of shares held by them;
  - 10.2 the number of scheme members represented by proxy at the scheme meeting and the number of shares held by them together with information as to the numbers represented by the Chairman in terms of proxies annexed to the scheme document;
  - 10.3 any proxies which have been disallowed;

- 10.4 all resolutions passed at the scheme meeting, with particulars of the number of votes cast in favour of and against each such resolution and of any abstentions;
- 10.5 all rulings made and directions given by the Chairman at the meeting or any adjournment thereof:
- 10.6 the relevant portions of documents and reports submitted or tabled at the scheme meeting or any adjournment thereof which bear on the merits or demerits of the scheme, including copies thereof; and
- 10.7 the main points of any other proposals which were submitted to the meeting or any adjournment thereof;

- 12. any scheme member wishing to vote by proxy should tender as his/her proxy the form of proxy referred to in paragraph 6.3 of this Order and that the form of proxy must be completed and returned in accordance with the instructions therein to the Applicant's transfer secretaries, namely, Transfer Secretaries (Pty) Ltd at Shop 8, Kaiserkrone Centre, Post Street Mall, Windhoek, Namibia (PO Box 2401, Windhoek, Namibia) or by fax (+264 61 248531), to be received by no later than 10:00 on Wednesday, 26 January 2005; and
- 13. the explanatory statement substantially in the form contained in the papers before this Honourable Court meets the requirements of Section 312(i)(a) of the Companies Act.
