## PROCEDURE FOR ADVERTISING IN THE GOVERNMENT GAZETTE OF THE REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA

- 2. Advertisements for publication in the *Government Gazette* (Estates) must be addressed to the *Government Gazette* Office, P.B. 13302, Windhoek, or be delivered at Justitia Building, Independence Avenue, Second Floor, Room 219, Windhoek, not later than 15:00 on the ninth working day before the date of publication of this *Government Gazette* in which the advertisement is to be inserted.
- 3. Advertisements are published in this *Government Gazette* for the benefit of the public and must be furnished in English by the advertiser or his agent.
- 4. Only legal advertisements shall be accepted for publication in the *Government Gazette* (Estates) and are subject to the approval of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Justice, who may refuse the acceptance of further publication of any advertisement.
- 5. The Ministry of Justice reserves the right to edit and revise copy and to delete there from any superfluous detail.
- 6. Advertisements must as far as possible be typewritten. The manuscript of advertisements must be written on one side of the paper only and all proper nouns plainly inscribed. - [b] To assist perpetrators and victims of violence, domestic abuse as well as HIV/AIDS infected and affected relatives in order to identify their problems and to address it by means of counselling.
- [c] To promote the effective functioning of families and communities by means of parental guidance, marriage enrichment and life skills training, as well as the establishment of a platform for discussing issues related to and affecting community development;
- [d] To engage local, regional and international donors to resource the programmes and activities of the organisation.
- [e] To engage partner congregations overseas for the training of volunteer staff, as well as for the resources and equipment needed for the successful implementation of the TEC activities;
- [f] To provide regular feedback to the Head Office of the ELCRIN and other stakeholders through the office of the congregational leader on the progress towards attaining its mission;
- [g] To liaise with Government and Non-Governmental Organisations, as well as other organisations of goodwill that deals with issues of mutual interest;
- [h] To encourage volunteer members to uphold TEC's Code of Ethics in advancing socio-economic upliftment.
