AMENDMENT OF GOVERNMENT NOTICE NO. 147 OF 30 AUGUST 2002, RELATING TO IMPOSITION OF GENERAL LEVIES ON CERTAIN CONTROLLED PRODUCTS: AGRONOMIC INDUSTRY ACT, 1992

I -

- (a) under section 18(3) of the Agronomic Industry Act, 1992 (Act No. 20 of 1992), amend Government Notice No. 147 of 30 August 2002 as set out in the Schedule; and
- (b) repeal Government Notice No. 125 of 15 May 2012.

Government Notice No. 147 of 30 August 2002 is amended by -

(a) the substitution for the Schedule of the following Schedule:

"SCHEDULE

- 1. Any person who produces and sells, excluding exports, for his or her or its benefit any controlled product, being agronomic crops set out in the Annexure to this Schedule must pay a general levy of one comma four percent (1.4%) on the selling price of the controlled product concerned.
- 2. Any person who imports into Namibia any controlled product set out in the Annexure to this Schedule, must pay a general levy of five percent (5%) on the landed cost of the controlled product so imported.
- 3. Any person who purchases controlled products from a person referred to in paragraph 1 or 2, must pay a general levy of one comma four percent (1.4%) on the selling price concerned or the landed cost concerned, as the case may be, of the controlled product so purchased.
- 4. For the purpose of paragraph 2 and 3 "landed cost" means the purchase price of the controlled product concerned, including any taxes, duties, and transport costs to the final destination in Namibia, payable in respect of the controlled product.
- 5. Any person who has paid a levy on behalf of another person, as contemplated in section 18(4) of the Agronomic Industry Act, 1992 (Act No. 20 of 1992), is entitled to recover the amount of that levy by deducting such amount from any amount due by him, her or it to the person on whose behalf the levy has been paid.
- 6. The levies referred to in this Schedule must be collected by Agro Marketing and Trade Agency (AMTA) appointed as an agent of the Namibia Agronomic Board in terms of General Notice No. 147 of 1 August 2014.".
