AMENDMENT OF GOVERNMENT NOTICE NO. 293 OF 2018: CIVIL AVIATION ACT, 2016

Under section 54 of the Civil Aviation Act, 2016 (Act No. 6 of 2016) I have, after consultation with the Board of Directors of the Namibia Civil Aviation Authority, amended Government Notice No. 293 of 8 November 2018, as amended by Government Notice No. 369 of 31 December 2018 and Government Notice No. 409 of 30 December 2019 by the substitution for paragraph (b) of the following paragraph -

- "(b) determined that the said regulations come into effect on the date of publication of this Notice, except for regulation 10 (relating to Part 139) which comes into effect as follows:
 - (i) Subpart 4 in relation to aerodromes in Category D, and Subpart 5 in relation to aerodromes in Category E, and any provision in Part 139 that refers to a Category D or E aerodrome, come into operation on 1 July 2021;
 - (ii) in relation to the Categories D and E aerodromes referred to in subparagraph (i), the Executive Director must, based on safety and security standards and recommended practices, make determinations in the interim period regarding the use of aerodromes by both commercial and non-commercial domestic air traffic of a maximum certified take-off mass of not more than 20 000 kilogrammes; and
 - (iii) all the other provisions of Part 139 come into effect on 1 May 2020.".
