RANKS IN THE FORCE

Members:

(b) Non-Officers:

- (i) Warrant Officer (1);
- (ii) Warrant Officer (2);
- (iii) Sergeant (1);
- (iv) Sergeant (2);
- (v) Constable;
- (vi) Cadet Constable”.

3. The following Schedule is substituted for Schedule D:

**“SCHEDULE D
(Regulation 28(1))**

BADGES, BATONS AND INSIGNIA OF RANK

1. Badges:

- (a) A twelve-pointed sun, in the centre of which appears the coat-of-arms of the Republic of Namibia within a circle. The words “Namibian Police” appear as circumscription on the rim of the circle above the coat of arms.
- (b) A shoulder-flash depicting the National Flag of the Republic of Namibia. The words “Police” and “Namibia” appear above and below the Flag, respectively, on the flash.

2. Batons:

Dome-shaped, embossed with the badge as described in paragraph 1(a).

3. Insignia of rank

Lieutenant-General	Crossed sword and baton below two separate fish eagles within a laurel wreath.
Major-General	Crossed sword and baton below one fish eagle within a laurel wreath.
Commissioner	Three suns in a triangle below one fish eagle within a laurel wreath.
Deputy Commissioner	Two suns below one fish eagle within a laurel wreath.
Chief Inspector	One sun below one fish eagle within a laurel wreath.

Inspector	Three suns.
Warrant Officer (1)	One fish eagle within a laurel wreath.
Warrant Officer (2)	A sun within a laurel wreath.
Sergeant (1)	A three-bar chevron below one fish eagle within a laurel wreath.
Sergeant (2)	A three-bar chevron below a sun.”.
